Terms and Conditions of Entry

- You may enter as many classes as you wish but only one entry per class per person.
- Each person entering classes has to use an entry form to themselves.
- Entries on the official form and fees of 30p each class entry to be submitted by Friday 9 September 2016 to Sue Robinson, 49 Medstead Road, Beech or to Helen Lamb, Highwood, Snode Hill, Beech.
- Exhibits to be brought to the Village Hall between **9.00am and 10.00am** on Sat 17th Sept.
- Where possible exhibitors should name varieties of grown produce to assist the judges and inform the rest of us!
- Your name should not be visible on your exhibit, but supplied, we suggest, on a small piece of card that can be placed face down on the display tables prior to judging.
- Fresh food items (classes 18 to 20) should be covered with clear film or presented in a large plastic bag.
- Judging will take place between 10.00 and 12 noon and the show will be open to the public from 12 noon.
- In addition to 1st, 2nd and highly-commended certificates, a points system will be operated and there will be an overall prize for MOST POINTS scored by an individual, as well as an award for BEST ENTRY IN SHOW.
- All entries are submitted at own risk. Beech Gardeners accept no responsibility for lost or damaged items. Please collect your entries at the end of the show.
